## DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Is there one of us who can't recall a favorite Dr. Seuss book? Children's literature was not always so intriguing. In 1936, to combat the dull early-reading books available at the time, Theodore Seuss Geisel had an idea for a book about a young child who dreams up an increasingly wacky story about his adventures walking home.

Geisel, returning from Europe on a steam ship, listened to the rhythm of the ship's steam engines, and followed their meter to write the words for this first book. When the 29th publisher he'd sent the story to finally agreed to print "And To Think I Saw It On Mulberry Street," literature changed forever.

The creators of Seussical the Musical obviously cherish Dr. Seuss books as much we do. They have captured the wit and creativity of his books, yet left plenty of room for interpretation by the performers. The story centers around Horton the Elephant, who finds himself faced with a double challenge. Not only must he protect his tiny friend Jojo and all the invisible Whos from a world of naysayers and dangers, but he must guard an abandoned egg, left to his care by the irresponsible Mayzie La Bird. Although Horton faces ridicule, danger, kidnapping and a trial, the intrepid Gertrude McFuzz never loses faith in him. Ultimately, the powers of friendship, loyalty, family and community are challenged and emerge triumphant.

At SPA we are privileged to be in the business of building strong people using the tools of music and theater. Thank you for being here to support our efforts and these wonderful students!
