Administrator's Notes:

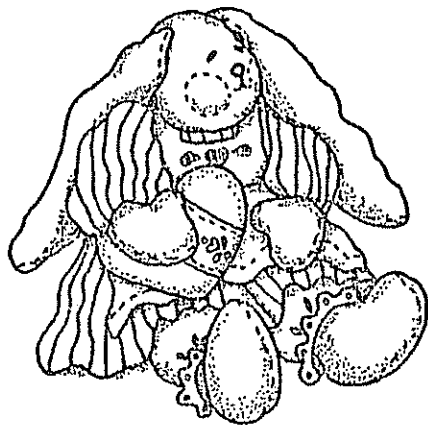
